GOAL AND TOPICS

The goal of the conference is to promote the exchange of ideas among economists conducting quantitative analysis for policy and decision making in the public and private sector. Particular emphasis will be placed on econometric and applied general equilibrium modeling. Related theoretical and applied work is welcome. The program will include both invited and contributed papers. In addition, there will be several discussion panels on specific topics.

The meeting will cover all areas of applied modeling for economics, finance and decision making in the government and business world. Papers on the following subjects are particularly solicited: European enlargement, European Monetary Union, environmental modeling, energy modeling, international monetary issues, international trade issues, regional integration, European Union and Mediterranean relations, European Union and developing countries, regional modeling, labor market issues in Europe, developing countries, tax issues in the EU, ageing and social security in the EU, forecasting issues.

JULY 5, 2001: Conference begins.
